

## Latest Update

A further £5.5 million of funds raised from public donations are to be distributed to survivors of the Grenfell Tower Disaster – the British Red Cross and K&C Foundation announced today. Working through the London Emergencies Trust and the Rugby Portobello Trust as distributors, new grants will be made to the 165 households affected by the fire and those bereaved and seriously injured are going to receive more funding.

The decisions on the further funding announced today continues to target those most in need in the community and recognises the continued distress, trauma and material loss faced by householders from Grenfell Tower and Grenfell Walk.

### **This phase of funding has three parts, specifically:**

- A grant of £15,000 will go to each of the 139 households from the Grenfell Tower,
- A grant of £8,000 will go to the 26 households in Grenfell Walk,
- The next of kin of those bereaved will receive a further £20,000 for every deceased victim on top of the £40,000 already provided through the London Emergencies Trust, bringing the total payment for every deceased to £60,000.
- Those who were hospitalised for a week or more by the fire are in line for a further £5,000, bringing the total in public donations passed to them from the London Fire Relief Fund up to £25,000.
